

2021-2022 FTCSC COVID-19 Plan

TOPIC	EXPECTATIONS
General Information	FTCSC has created this updated 2021-2022 plan based on known information at this time. Mandates from the Marion County Public Health Department or another health agency could cause the plan to change.
Masks/Face Coverings	 Grades K-12: Masks are optional inside of schools. Bus Riders are required to wear masks on buses, according to a federal mandate. Note: It is recommended that ALL STUDENTS, including car riders, bring a mask to school every day in case their parent/guardian instructs them to ride the bus due to unexpected circumstances.
Nurses Clinic Locations	 Schools will have a designated area for students displaying COVID-19 symptoms and waiting to be picked up.
Symptom Screenings	 FTCSC Families are expected to screen their children and keep them home if they are ill. Students and staff should stay at home if they have a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or exhibit a COVID-19 symptom. Staff members will need to follow the daily COVID-19 email protocol for symptom screening.
Water Bottles	 Water Bottle filling stations will remain in place. Water fountains will only be available to refill water bottles.
Handwashing	 FTCSC encourages students and staff to regularly wash your hands. Hand sanitizer will continue to be available in classrooms and common areas.
Vaccination and Testing	 Being vaccinated is one way to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. COVID-19 Testing is reliable and sites are available in our area.
Cleaning and Disinfecting	 Desks and hard surfaces will continue to be disinfected regularly. Teachers and staff will continue to use sanitizer and cleaning products as needed throughout the school day. School air filtration systems meet all requirements for the amount of fresh air circulating.
Physical Distancing	 Classroom spacing of 3 feet is recommended. Contact tracing will be conducted for individuals within 6 feet. Students will use lockers this year.
Visitors	Visitors may enter the building. Joining students for lunch is not permitted.
School Bus	Per Federal Mandate, the use of mask/face coverings will be required on school buses and all forms of public transportation.
School Meals	 Students will cohort at the same lunch table. Visitors will not be permitted to eat lunch with students.
Field Trips	 All Field Trips will be approved on a case by case basis. All participants will be expected to follow the restrictions of the destination area.
Athletics and Extracurricular	 IHSAA and ISSMA Guidelines will be followed. Event seating capacity will be determined by the IHSAA and MCPHD.
