


Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

Mac OS Enrollment Steps:

1. Navigate to enrollment.ftcsc.org on your device and look through the Terms and Conditions
2. Choose the group labeled “Students”





4. Download the Cloudpath Mac OS file

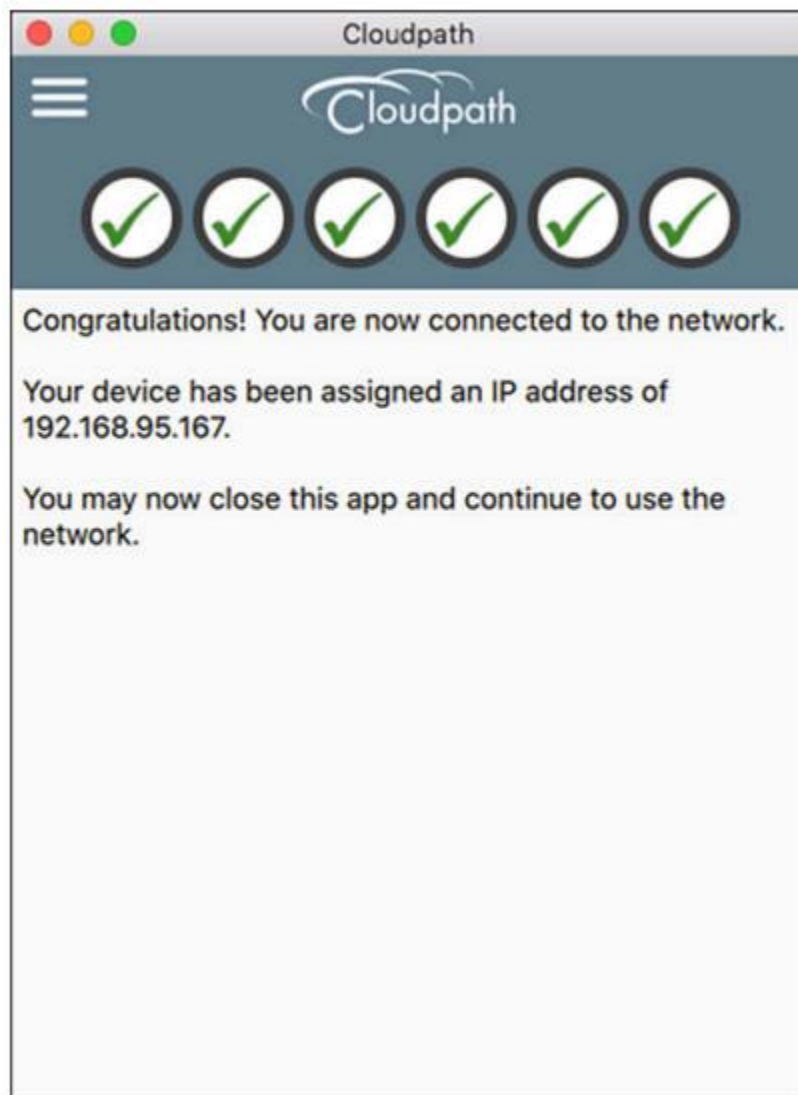
5. Browse to your downloads folder, open the Cloudpath folder and run the app



6. Enter your local Mac credentials to allow changes. This is the same username and password you use to log into the Mac. You may need to enter them multiple times as the install progresses.



7. After the installation is complete, connect to the FT-BYOD network if not already
